Mouth \sim is a $\mathbb{C}_{\underline{\hspace{1cm}}}$ for words
The words of the mouth are deep waters, Proverbs 18:4
Tongue ~ C // Shapes // Aims
The words of the reckless pierce like swords, Proverbs 12:18
Lips ~ C out words with power
From the fruit of their lips people are filled with good things, Proverbs 12:14.
In chapter 10 of Proverbs Solomon shifts from Wisdom to Righteousness.
